

Burundi Bridge Corner Construction



Overview

The bridge's reconstruction began on October 2, 2023 for a period of 13 months and 15 days, is currently financed by the World, once completed it is expected to facilitate the free movement of goods and people between the two partner states. Burundi's new road bridge project will provide a key lifeline. The new Kaburantwa bridge links Burundi with the Democratic Republic of Congo (DR Congo), spanning the Kaburantwa River. Recently, a World Bank delegation visited a bridge over the Rusizi river in Burundi, which is being constructed by CCC First Highway Engineering. Accompanied by two deputies from Bururi commune, on Saturday, November 22, 2025, the Second Deputy Speaker of the Senate, Honourable Clotilde Kampimbare, joined the residents of Muzenga zone in Bururi commune, Burunga province, for the construction of retaining walls for a bridge built on Siguvyaye. The General Director of road maintenance, Salfo Paceré, representing the minister in charge of infrastructure, visited on Friday August 9, 2024 the development work on the Takaledougou bridge in the commune of Banfora on the RN7, the axis Banfora-Bobo. Site supervision, including design approval, construction supervision, quality management, planning control, health and safety coordination and quantity surveying.
