A minimum clearance of 23 cm (9 in) should be maintained between the top of a tray and beams, piping, etc., to facilitate installation of cables in the tray. In general, vertical spacing for cable trays should be 30 cm (12 in), measured from the bottom of the upper tray to. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require. When offloading tray from a flat deck trailer using an overhead crane, care should be exercised in the placement and length of the slings to prevent crushing the product (siderails). Only.
