

What color should be used for external wiring in the distribution box



Overview

The mandatory colors for power wiring in the National Electrical Code (NEC) are Green, Bare, or Green/Yellow (a yellow stripe or band on green) for the protective ground (PG), and White (or alternatively Gray) for the neutral wire. Wiring color codes are the wires' colors used to connect electrical devices and circuits. These codes help us to follow the safety rules. Note:- Different countries have different wiring color codes. It makes it easier and safer to. The choice of cable colour initially depends on what type of circuit it is, and whether the voltage is AC or DC. Using the correct wiring color codes is crucial for identifying line, neutral, and ground wires, which saves time, simplifies maintenance and troubleshooting, and ensures the safety of.
