

What to do if the monitoring access switch cannot be found



Overview

Go to the Device Inventory and look at the current "Reachability" & "Manageability" Status. If "Device Unreachable", you can click on the error and it will show you things to look at. This is typically an SNMP issue or one of the Credential issues. Error: command failed: IP address "x". SIGN IN New to NetApp?
